  - The ranch is about 1:15 minutes' drive (50 miles) N.E. of Payson. Please make sure you fill your gas tank in Payson because there will not be any opportunity to gas up after that.

- o Travel to the McDonalds in Payson, Arizona which is at the intersection of Highway 87 and Highway 260. From the McDonalds in Payson.
- o Turn right on **Highway 260** and take Highway 260 toward Heber, AZ for roughly 30 miles.
- O Soon after mile **marker 282**, take a left on **Rim Road 300** (also known as the road to Woods Canyon Lake).
- o Take Rim Road 300 for roughly **9 miles** until you come to a **Stop Sign at the "T" junction** of Rim Road 300 and FR 34 (also known as Wallace Road). *Gravel roads from here to the ranch*.
- Take a Right onto FR 34 (Wallace Road) and go 6.8 miles and then take a left on FR75 (also called Hart Canyon Loop). Note: at approximately 3 miles you will pass the first turn off to FR75.
- o Turn left (West) onto FR75 for 1.8 miles to the property. This is just after Mile Marker 4.
- O You'll see private property signs every 100 feet on the side of the road that look like stop signs. That's our property. You'll see a large cabin and pavilion take that road to the pavilion.
